The entire community is welcome to attend the regular Finneytown Civic Association meeting, Sunday, March 21 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in upper Room A in the Senior/Community Center, located on the Springfield Township Administrative campus, 9158 Winton Road.

The superintendent, board members, and supporters from the Finneytown Local Schools will be on hand to explain the need for the May 4<sup>th</sup> vote on a 7.9% Operating Levy.

The meeting-in-the-round will offer residents the opportunity to voice concerns, ask questions, and offer funding ideas. Many homeowners in Finneytown already feel overburdened with high property taxes and many are nervous that their property values are falling faster than their ability to pay existing taxes. With this shaky economy, we have a lot of nervous taxpayers who, in the history of Finneytown Schools, have willingly paid their fair share to support our small district (about 1600 students).
